






Plant Germination

The seed starts to grow under the soil.




pollination

The plant grows flowers.






The plant grows toward the sun. Its leaves start to make food.





Earth Structure





- 1. Continental Crust This is the outer layer where we live. It's like the frosting on the cake. It's thin and hard.
- 2. Oceanic crust lies beneath the ocean, consisting mainly of dense, basaltic rocks and forming the ocean floor.
- 3. **Mantle** Below the crust is the mantle, which is like the cake's sponge. It's thicker and can flow slowly, kind of like thick, gooey syrup.
- 4. Outer Core Beneath the mantle is the outer core, which is very hot and liquid, like melted chocolate.

 It's made of metals like iron and nickel.
- 5. Inner Core At the very center is the inner core, which is solid and very hot, like a super-heated metal ball.
