



# MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF PROVINCIAL INSTITUTE FOR TEACHER EDUCATION



Balochistan has been described as fertile land; a metaphor used to describe the human potential of the indigenous people of Balochistan. However, this potential remains untapped due to limited access and poor-quality educational experiences. The few exposed to educational opportunities are reined in by outdated teaching and practices which are deeply embedded in rote learning. The innate talent of the young gets lost in teaching practices that kill creativity and questioning powers.

Data from the field exposed the inadequacies of teaching and learning across the province. In a conscious effort to ease the organic issues of education in Balochistan, extensive and intensive research was conducted to select and contextualize strategies that looked most promising in the given situation. During the exploration and planning stage, it was realized that foundational literacy and numeracy skills are key to boosting the education of fledgling minds. The loss of education i.e., not studying (basic skills) at the right level creates gaping pits in the learning and development of children. Once lost, no matter how much effort is exerted the gaps in learning will remain throughout life.


To catch children at the right age for brain development and learning it is imperative to introduce the concept of Teaching at the Right Level (TaRL). Through the Remedial Learning Camp Programme (RLCP) developed for the marginalized children of Balochistan foundational literacy and numeracy skills are being targeted within the school system. As discussed in every segment of society and within each tier of the education sector of Balochistan foundation literacy and numeracy skills are key to optimising lifelong opportunities for children across Balochistan.

Given the multi-dimensional educational crisis in Balochistan, the RLCP is the brainchild of several education experts whose forte lies in developing organic curriculums and programs. The collective wisdom of several brilliant minds has put in great efforts to create a sustainable model of education that will fill the gaps in learning and teaching. Active and joyful learning is an integral part of this program.

This RLCP defies the current norms and educational practices of rote learning and text-heavy practices and is a huge departure from ordinary classroom practice. It is hoped that the Teacher Diaries, Student Workbooks, and Teaching Aids along with consistent support through monitoring and mentoring will not only enrich children's learning experience but also bring smiles to their beautiful faces.


